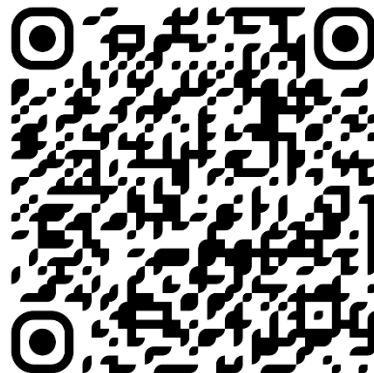

# TERMS & CONDITIONS

## 1. Date & Location of Show

The Show will be held on 19<sup>th</sup> & 20<sup>th</sup> August 2026 the County Showground, Withybush, Haverfordwest, Pembrokeshire, SA62 4BW

## 2. Cancellation of Classes and/or Entries

Pembrokeshire Agricultural Society reserves the right to refuse any entry or cancel or amalgamate any class or section it deems fit. Exhibitors already entered will be offered entry into an alternative section where appropriate or the entry fee may be returned to each exhibitor after the show dates.

## 3. Stewards

No steward or other official of the show, whilst in charge of any animal competing in the show, shall wear any rosette or badge when they enter the ring

## 4. Dress Code

All exhibitors/handlers should ensure they are wearing the correct show clothing and footwear required to enter the designated show rings

## 5. Public liability

All exhibitors, without exception, must have public liability/third party insurance

## 6. Health & Safety

The organizers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health & safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers, officials and stewards. Please ensure that all animals are show trained and that all show equipment is in good condition.

## 7. Animal Welfare

Pembrokeshire Agricultural Society is very keen to ensure the health and welfare of all livestock that attend the events that the Society organises. Show organisers have an obligation (under the terms of the Animal Welfare Act 2006 Section 9(2)) to ensure that the best welfare practices are observed at all times and this also assists in the prevention of the spread of animal diseases. This involves working to the regulations and guidelines set out by government organisations, and developing policies and procedures that can be compiled with by the society's representatives e.g. staff and voluntary workers, exhibitors and the general public. The PAS Welfare Plan has been drawn up with the assistance of the society's appointed veterinary surgeons, Fenton Veterinary Practice & Cotts Farm Equine Hospital and demonstrates that due consideration had been given to all aspects of animal health and welfare. The plan is available for inspection by the animal health authorities if required. The society is keen to promote equine welfare and as part of this we encourage all riders, no matter where they are on the showground, to be of an appropriate size and weight for the horse/pony being ridden.

## 8. GDPR and Data Protection Act 1998

The society rules regarding the above are currently in accordance with the Data Protection Act 1998. To enable the society to deliver its services to you, there is need for you to continue providing personal data. With GDPR the security of your personal data is of paramount importance to the society. The society has developed a Privacy Policy which can be found on our website. Class 1 AE	50cm
Class 2 AE	60cm
Class 3 AE	70cm
Class 4 AE	80cm
Class 5 AE	90cm

## Rules

- The winner will be the competitor with the lowest number of penalties; in the event of a tie the winner will be decided by the timed section.
- **There will be no optimum time around the whole course.**
- **There will be a timed section, which will consist of four fences, completed in any direction/order.**
- Each rider can enter a maximum of three horses/ponies per class.
- No age restrictions, however, riders must be suitably mounted.
- Body protectors and hats to current specifications must be worn, with no fixed peaks.
- There will be no more than 25 jumping efforts in total, cross country jumps will be solid and fixed, there may be a bullfinch and water trays.
- Stop watches are not permitted.
- The judge's decision is final.
- Penalties will be incurred for refusals and knock downs:
  - There will be 10 penalties for first refusal, 20 penalties for a second refusal, three refusals equal elimination.
- knock down will be 4 penalties.
- Horses/ponies must be four years old and over.
- There will be a mounted presentation at the end of each class.
- Entry to the final will be £20.
- Entries to be made via [www.showingscene.com](http://www.showingscene.com)
- Rosettes to 6th place.

These classes are qualifiers for the NPS/Anthony Evans Arena Eventing Challenge Final. No membership is required to qualify. Any pony (158cm or under) achieving a top ten finish will qualify for the final to be held on 14<sup>th</sup> September at Vale View Equestrian Centre.
